The *Sun Dual FastEthernet and Dual SCSI/P Adapter Release Notes* describes limitations and requirements discovered since the *Sun Dual FastEthernet and Dual SCSI/P Adapter Installation and User's Guide* was printed.

Supported Cables

Page 3 of the *Sun Dual FastEthernet and Dual SCSI/P Adapter Installation and User's Guide* lists the following supported cables, which you can order from Sun Microsystems:

- X1132A 530-2452-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P.8M)
- X3832A 530-2453-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P 2M)
- X3830A 530-2454-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P 4M)
- X3831A 530-2455-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P 10M)

Any of these four cables can be used for SCSI LVD devices. However, if you want to hook up SCSI Single Ended SE devices, you must specify the following two cables:

- X1132A 530-2452-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P.8M)
- X3832A 530-2453-02 (CBL,ULTRA SCSI-3/VHDCI,68P 2M)

Product Limitations

Only one Netra-S1 per channel is currently supported. This limitation applies to *all* platforms, including Netra platforms.

This product requires the Solaris 8 2/02 operating environment. Other versions of the Solaris operating environment are not currently supported.

Required Patches

The following patch may be required to install Sun Dual Fast Ethernet and Dual SCSI/P adapter on your system.

- Patch-ID Number 111883-07

Install the latest version of Patch-ID Number 111883. (The dash number -07) becomes higher with each new version of the patch.) The -05 version is in the Solaris 8 2/02 operating environment. If you install the Solaris operating environment after physically installing the card, you must do a `pkgadd` again from the CD or get Patch-ID Number 111883-07 from the SunSolve web site

If the patch is not available on SunSolve, contact your local sales or service representative.

Troubleshooting

This section lists known problems and their solutions.

Problem Showing Devices

If 12 target devices are connected to any SCSI channel, you will see only 11 devices during `probe-scsi-all` at the `ok` prompt. When the Solaris operating environment is booted up, you will see all 12 devices.

Link-up/Link-down Problem

If you have not installed Patch-ID Number 111883-07, you may see a link-down message immediately followed by a link-up message. This is normal and does not affect either performance or connectivity.

Problem with Fujitsu Drives

Ultra SCSI Combo-6 boxes with Fujitsu MAA, MAB series drives are not supported due to signal integrity issues with the Fujitsu drives.
