

# VERITAS Storage Foundation 4.0 Software Release Notes Supplement for the Solaris Operating System

This document supplements the VERITAS Storage Foundation 4.0 Release Notes, Solaris and the VERITAS Storage Foundation 4.0 Release Notes, Solaris, Maintenance Pack 1.

# **Co-operative Support Program**

To ensure compatibility of VERITAS products on Sun platforms, Sun and VERITAS perform significant joint testing. However, Sun does not provide front-line support for VERITAS products that are not price-listed by Sun. In an effort to make sure all joint customer support issues are resolved efficiently, Sun and VERITAS have implemented the Co-operative Support model under the SunVIP<sup>SM</sup> program. Under this program, customers who hold a SunSpectrum GOLD or PLATINUM support contract with Sun and a support contract with VERITAS can engage either company for support and resolution. Sun and VERITAS will engage each other as appropriate to solve joint (or unidentified) issues.

# Sun StorEdge T3 and T3+ Arrays Support in a Multi-Host Environment

In a multi-host configuration the Sun StorEdge<sup>TM</sup> T3 and T3+ arrays must be configured to use the MPxIO mode (explicit failover). In this mode, the Sun StorEdge Traffic Manager Software MPxIO driver on the host handles multipathing. VERITAS Volume Manager (VxVM) does not see multiple paths to any device on the array.

The /kernel/drv/scsi\_vhci.conf file on the host must have the MPxIO mode enabled (for example, mpxio-disable=no). Use the sys mp\_support=mpxio command on the Sun StorEdge T3 or T3+ array to enable MPxIO mode.

**Note** – All hosts in the clustered environment must use the MPxIO mode.

#### **Documentation Errata**

- Contrary to a statement in the *VERITAS Volume Manager 4.0 Installation Guide, Solaris,* the Volume Manager 4.0 Maintenance Pack 1 can be installed by all users, regardless of whether the product was purchased from Sun or VERITAS.
- In the VERITAS Volume Manager 4.0 Installation Guide, Solaris the following note is invalid and should be removed from pages 30, 66, 70, 75, 80, and 85:

**Note** – The VERITAS packages and patches are not compressed when you purchase VERITAS Volume Manager through Sun Microsystems. If you purchased the VERITAS packages and patches through Sun Microsystems, do not install patch 115217-xx.

■ In the VERITAS Volume Manager 4.0 Installation Guide, Solaris the following statement is invalid and should be removed from pages 27 and 60:

The following VxVM patch is only required for Storage Foundation customers: 115217-xx (for the VRTSvxvm package)

- The VERITAS Volume Manager 4.0 Installation Guide, Solaris and the VERITAS File System 4.0 Installation Guide, Solaris documents might direct you to contact VERITAS Customer Support for the license key. Instead, contact a Sun License Center, as described on the VERITAS Proof of License Certificate.
- Contrary to a statement in the *VERITAS File System 4.0 Release Notes*, the new Intent Log Resize feature *is* supported in the Sun Microsystems distribution of the VERITAS File System 4.0.

# VRTSmufp VERITAS Volume Manager Package on Language CD-ROM

The VRTSmufp package is included on the Language CD-ROM for VERITAS Volume Manager 4.0 for Solaris<sup>TM</sup>, but it is not required in the Japanese (Ja), French (Fr), or Simplified Chinese (Zh) locales. However, the VRTSmufp package is required if you are installing VERITAS File System 4.0 for Solaris in the Japanese locale.
