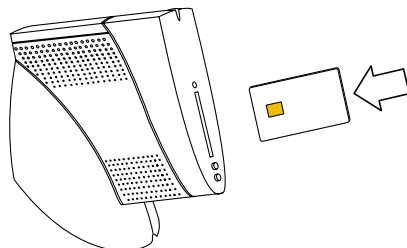
Icon	What it means	Action to take
	<p>The unit is starting up.</p>	<p>Wait. If the unit does not start within a short time, contact your system administrator.</p>
	<p>A unit failure has occurred. The unit tried to download from the server to the PROM, but failed.</p>	<p>Contact your system administrator.</p>
	<p>The unit does not detect an Ethernet signal. The unit's Ethernet address is displayed.</p>	<p>Check that the Ethernet cable is correctly plugged into the back of the unit and into the correct network outlet. If the problem persists, contact your system administrator.</p>
	<p>The unit cannot communicate with the server software.</p>	<p>Contact your system administrator.</p>
	<p>The sound has been muted.</p>	<p>Press the mute key again or use the Settings screen (Shift+Props) to unmute the sound.</p>
	<p>The volume has been changed.</p>	<p>Press either of the volume keys or use the Settings screen (Shift+Props) to adjust the volume.</p>
	<p>The server is currently downloading to the unit's PROM.</p>	<p>Wait—do not power cycle the unit. The unit will restart when downloading is complete.</p>




	<p>The unit's Ethernet address is displayed when the three audio volume control keys are pressed simultaneously or the Ethernet cable is initially plugged in.</p>	<p>The address disappears after 15 seconds.</p>
	<p>Prompt for smart card insertion.</p>	<p>Insert smart card.</p>
	<p>Unit cannot read smart card.</p>	<p>Insert smart card properly. Clean contacts on smart card and reinsert. Contact your system administrator.</p>
	<p>You are denied access.</p>	<p>Contact your system administrator.</p>

LED	State	What it means
	Off	The unit is not plugged in.
	Yellow	The LED briefly lights for 2-3 seconds at power on while the unit checks the hardware. If this LED stays on, or lights at any other time, a hardware fault has occurred. Contact your system administrator for a replacement unit.
	Green	The unit is powered on and the hardware is functioning normally.
	Blinking	The unit is inoperable. Contact your system administrator to correct the problem.
	Off	No smart card is inserted.
	On	The smart card has been inserted correctly.
	Blinking	It is safe to enter your secure PIN now (secure smart card installations only).
